VOLT ACADEMY

The Volt Academy is a rigorous industry-aligned, 7-week vocational program that ensures trainees are ready for in-demand, high-wage career pathways. Trainees will complete a 1-week Job Readiness/Soft Skills training and a 6-week course intensive vocational training. This includes classroom instruction, preparation for industry-recognized certifications, work-based learning experiences, and employment opportunities.

SYEP ENRICHMENT SUMMER
